

Euthanasia is a violation of God's sovereignty. God alone has the right to take life, and we should not presume to take the life of another person.



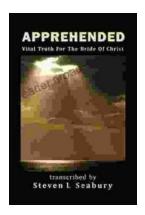
