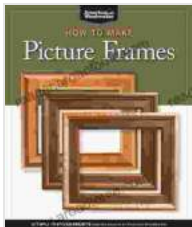

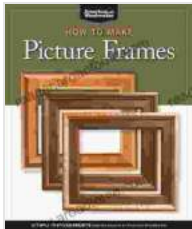
Tips

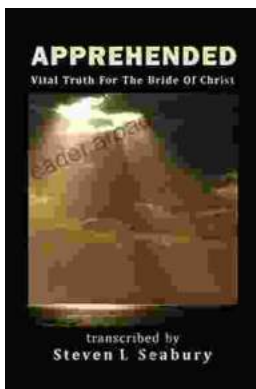
